Make it happen with those loved ones who are currently in your life! Explore possibilities on how to create a loving, living tribute to your loved one.

Liza Ely has been helping people create Celebration Circles to honor loved ones, many of whom were facing end-of-life transitions. However, the concept can be used for anyone who may be struggling and is in pain, who could benefit from being reminded of their best, or who has made a difference in your life. This approach is non-denominational and is appropriate for any religious background.

Liza will talk about the concept and her experiences, how you can plan celebration circles, what forms they can take, why holiday gatherings present the perfect opportunity, and how to facilitate them. This talk could be interesting for anyone involved in hospice care, counseling, planning elder or special birthday parties, or just wishing to honor someone special.
